



Rules and Regulations of the “*Explorer Expeditions for Highlander Treasures*” Quest Badge

I. General Provisions

1. The “*Quests – Explorer Expeditions*” Programme shall hereby establish the “*Explorer Expeditions for Highlander Treasures*” Quest Badge, hereinafter referred to as “*the Badge*”.
2. The purpose of the Badge shall be to popularise the Quest activity format, and promote sightseeing and tourism qualities of the south Małopolska region.
3. Any individual taking action to earn the Badge shall be required to observe the letter of Polish law, and standards commonly accepted in Poland. Any individual taking action to earn the Badge shall be required to respect natural and cultural heritage resources.

II. Badge Classes. Terms and Conditions of Earning the Badge.

1. The Badge shall be available to individuals 6 years of age or older.
2. Actions to earn the Badge shall be taken exclusively in the south Małopolska region.
3. The Badge shall be established and available in the following classes:
 - Basic,
 - Bronze,
 - Silver,
 - Gold.
4. The Badge shall be earned and awarded according to the aforementioned class sequence, Basic to Gold.
5. Any individual with a User Account registered on the www.questy.org.pl website and capable of proving in a manner duly described herein that he/she has completed a specific number of “*Highlander Treasures*” group Quests available in sources listed below shall have the right to apply for the Badge, said sources including:
 - The www.questy.org.pl website and “*Quests – Explorer Expeditions*” app at <https://questy.com.pl/#grupa-skarby-gorali>
 - The www.skarbygorali.pl website and “*Highlander Treasures*” app
6. Primary Quest completion proof shall comprise www.questy.org.pl data (Quests completed using the “*Highlander Treasures*” mobile app shall be lodged on www.questy.org.pl website User Accounts automatically). While an individual taking action to earn the Badge will not be obliged to keep a personal record or Explorer Passport / Highlander Treasure Chronicle, he/she may choose to do so for personal convenience.
7. Detailed terms and conditions for earning the Badge, respective Badge classes included, have been listed below:

Book "Highlander Treasures. Meet a non-Podhale Highlander"		10	No more than 2 virtual quests
Basic		5	No more than 1 virtual quest
Bronze		15	No more than 2 virtual quests
Silver		50	No more than 5 virtual quests
Gold		100	No more than 10 virtual quests

- Users are encouraged to earn the Badge concurrently with taking action to earn other Quest and tourist & sightseeing badges.

III. Badge Awarding Procedure

- Once the User has met all Rules and Regulations requirements, the fact of such User having earned the Badge shall be confirmed by relevant notification, and by a system-generated code lodged on the User's Account on the www.questy.org.pl website.



2. Once the Badge award notification has been issued, any individual concerned shall have the right to acquire the Badge of the respective class. Badges shall be distributed by the *Map of Passions* Foundation office. Any User wishing to order a prize and/or Badge shall send an e-mail message to the Foundation (e-mail address: biuro@mapapasji.pl), specifying his/her login on the www.questy.org.pl website, and the Badge code received.

IV. Final Provisions

1. The “*Quests – Explorer Expeditions*” Programme shall hereby reserve the right to modify the Rules and Regulations for the Badge without any obligation to specify reasons for such modification(s). Any resultant changes shall come into force as of the date of their publication in Rules and Regulations.
2. Any doubts potentially arising with regard to interpreting these Rules and Regulations shall be resolved by the “*Quests – Explorer Expeditions*” Programme Team.
